<sup>ii</sup> Farmer Family Learning Group approach is a participatory learning by doing process where smallholder organic farmers come together and with the guidance of a “facilitator” find feasible solutions to improve their farming based on what is naturally and locally available on their farms. Where solutions are to be sought out side of the individual farm, the approach emphasizes not to think of “shopped” solutions but rather focus on solutions given by nature and human nurtured inter-farm interactions. Thus, the farmer family develops their farm not in isolation but as part of the system of different farms which are continuously interacting.



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
